



John Young Scholarship in the Arts at Kapi'olani Community College 2013

Two (2) \$2,000 awards available

It is the intention of the John Young Foundation to establish, through the University of Hawai'i Foundation, an annual scholarship fund to be used according to the following terms and conditions.

- **PURPOSE:**

This scholarship is established to assist students in the Fine Arts or New Media Arts at Kapi'olani Community College.

- **ELIGIBILITY:**

Recipients **MUST** be a graduate of a Hawai'i high school, enrolled with 9 credits or more, and be in the Fine Arts or New Media Arts Program at Kapi'olani Community College.

- **CRITERIA:**

- Applicant must demonstrate some degree of financial need, not necessarily as defined by federal guidelines. A written statement of long term goals and explanation of financial need must be submitted.
- Applicant must be in good academic standing at Kapi'olani Community College or former high school or college. (2.0 GPA or higher)
- Evidence of talent, as determined by portfolio submission to be evaluated by selection committee review. (5-6 works)
- Enrolled at KCC for next two semesters, minimum 9 credits in the semester of application.
- Submission of completed application form.

- **SELECTION:**

A committee of art faculty at Kapi'olani Community College will select recipients.

- **NOTIFICATION:**

The Office of the Chancellor of Kapi‘olani Community College shall notify recipients of their selection. Announcement of the scholarship will occur once the agreement has been signed and accepted. The University of Hawaii Foundation shall arrange for payment of the scholarship.

- **NUMBER AND AMOUNT OF AWARDS:**

Up to two (2) awards of \$2000 each will be awarded.

- **RENEWAL:**

Recipients are eligible for one scholarship renewal as long as all criteria are met. (maximum of 2 years)

- **APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE:**

- Completed and signed “Private Scholarships” Application Form. Applications can be picked up at the Koa Gallery, in art classrooms or downloaded at <http://koagallery.kcc.hawaii.edu/>.
- Completed one-page typed statement of long term goals and financial need (as explained on application.)
- Portfolio of 5-6 works.
- Recipients must show proof of enrollment at Kapi‘olani Community College (Proof of enrollment form can be found on the KCC website. <http://kapiolani.hawaii.edu/page/search.html>)
- Applicants should show proof of current GPA (2.0 GPA or higher).
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher about potential.
